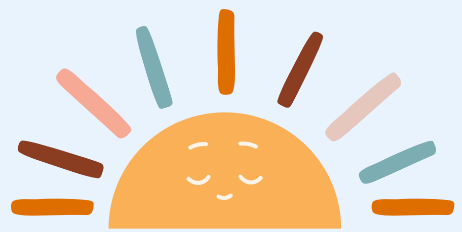

OCTOBER TERM WRAP UP!



Since the weather has been so fabulous this month, our program has had a big focus on outdoor play! This has been facilitated by planned experiences such as musical chairs, netball, and sandcastle competitions. As well, children have been encouraged to explore outdoor spontaneous play options, including the very popular soccer and basketball, as well as some more relaxing outdoor activities like board games. The outdoor spontaneous play this month has been further supported by our use of rotational play spaces such as Gamaratta, block f playground, and the sandpit. In these spaces children have been able to engage in dramatic outdoor play, acting out intense pirate ship battles and volcanic adventures!

Whilst we have been loving outdoor play recently, we have still enjoyed awesome indoor play across the month, including making paper plate chickens, hosting fooseball tournaments, and cooking pancakes!



SEPT-OCT VAC-CARE WRAP UP



Our most recent vacation care program was jam packed with fun learning opportunities for the children! We had an awesome mix of STEM, art, and sport-based incursion activities, including rock climbing and a dinosaur show. We also filled the rest of our program with awesome in-house activities, such as making fruit skewers and playing put-put golf courses. We had some exciting new experiences, such as retro arcade gaming, as well as some returning crowd favourites, like the silent disco!

As well as these, we took the children on two awesome excursions. The first was to Calmsley City Farm, where children got to feed and pet some farm animals! The second was to palace cinema, where the children had a theatre all to themselves to watch the Australian movie Kangaroo!



CLUBS!

LOOSH is re-introducing clubs to our programming this term!

Each club will run in the same session each week, allowing children to continually build on their skills and learning through a carefully curated program made by our educators.

Sewing Club!

Every Tuesday morning, a wonderful sewing club will be run by educator Eva. Each week, children will build their sewing skills in order to make pompoms, friendship bracelets, and even their own pencil case!



Cooking Club!

On Wednesday mornings and Monday afternoons (alternate weeks), cooking club will be running. Children will be able to make a range of foods, enhancing their understanding of nutrition and ability to follow recipes. In Term 4, we will be running a lunchbox series!



Handball Club!

Every Tuesday morning, a super cool handball club will run at LOOSH. Children will get to play handball games, whilst also engaging in skill-development sessions focused on trick shots and improving their game plans!



Art Club!

Every Thursday afternoon, the children will channel their inner Van Gogh when they get creative in art club! The children will learn about different art styles, as well as how to use different artistic materials.

Resources for children and families:

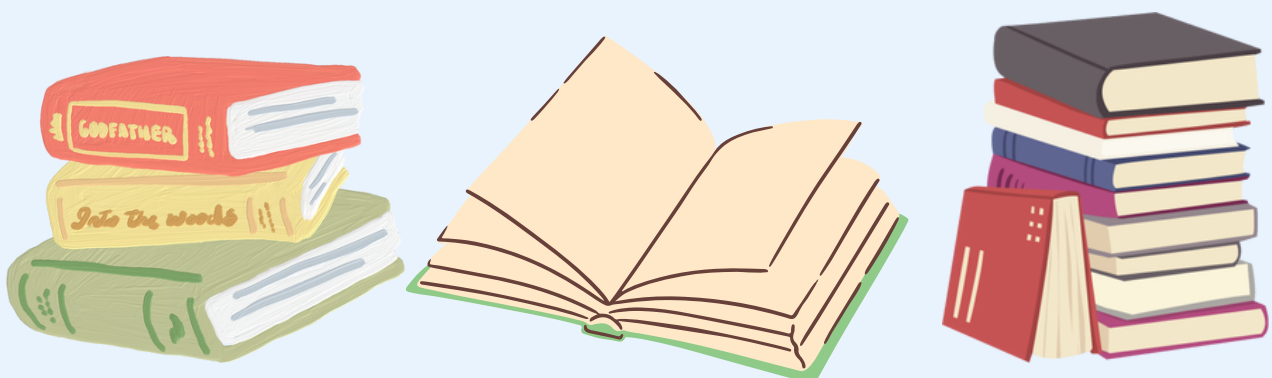
- ***Our Skin: A First Conversation About Race*** by Megan Madison, Jessica Ralli and Isabel Roxas

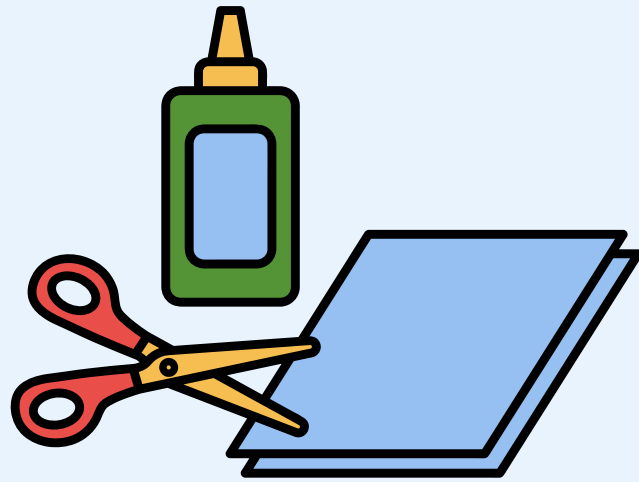


OTHER REMINDERS
