

Special Arrangements


If your child is attending a lesson, please ensure you have submitted a special arrangement form no later than 1:30pm the day of an ASC lesson or the day before for a BSC lesson.

NOVEMBER TERM WRAP UP!



This month the LOOSH program has offered a wide range of programmed and spontaneous activities for the children. Outdoor play such as soccer, obstacle courses, and handball tournaments have encouraged children to build both their gross-motor skills and sportsmanship. Alongside this, children's creativity has been pushed through crafts like bracelet making and hama beads, as well as our weekly art club. STEM content such as biology has been explored in our primary garden experiences, and children have utilised technology for educational purposes in experiences such as geo-guesser. Cooking activities such as making sandwiches and scones allow children to practice following detailed series of instructions, developing their critical thinking. Alongside this, activities like our Year 6 x Kindy picnic built children's communication skills, and facilitated the development of strong peer relationships at LOOSH!

Through a varied program, children can access a range of skill-development opportunities, and can see all of their interests reflected across the program!



CLUBS!

LOOSH is re-introducing clubs to our programming this term!

Each club will run in the same session each week, allowing children to continually build on their skills and learning through a carefully curated program made by our educators.

Sewing Club!

Every Tuesday morning, a wonderful sewing club will be run by educator Eva. Each week, children will build their sewing skills in order to make pompoms, friendship bracelets, and even their own pencil case!



Cooking Club!

On Wednesday mornings and Monday afternoons (alternate weeks), cooking club will be running. Children will be able to make a range of foods, enhancing their understanding of nutrition and ability to follow recipes. In Term 4, we will be running a lunchbox series!



Handball Club!

Every Tuesday morning, a super cool handball club will run at LOOSH. Children will get to play handball games, whilst also engaging in skill-development sessions focused on trick shots and improving their game plans!



Art Club!

Every Thursday afternoon, the children will channel their inner Van Gogh when they get creative in art club! The children will learn about different art styles, as well as how to use different artistic materials.

FAMILY CORNER


LOOSH educators come across many useful resources. We would love to share helpful resources to families as an extra support. Below are some fabulous resources we wanted to share with you:
